HS: Headset Profile.

HF: Handsfree. The handsfree profile is a much richer profile for the car kit application, supporting more features.

SAP : Sim Access Profile only for the CK3500 car kit

Note 1 : Some phone software versions allow to configure the phone in the headset profile only.

Note 2 : The whole phonebook is automatically transferred to the CK3100.

Note 3 : This feature is not useful because the phone does not support dialing from the car kit.

Note 4 : You can synchronize your phonebook by using a third party software : Nokia_810_contacts_sync_3_10,

The synchronization is not automatic : you have to launch this soft each time you want to actualize the phonebook of the car kit,

Note 5 : Before sending contacts over Bluetooth to the carkit, activate the Special Menu (refer to: Settings > Advanced Settings > Object Push, and select D500, MyX-8).

Then from the phone, select the contacts you want to send over Bluetooth.

* : These phones need a special pairing mode (see "Advanced Settings" and "Pair with phone..." in the CK3100 Menu).

** : These phones are not able to send contacts over Bluetooth, but it is possible to use a third Bluetooth device to send contacts to the carkit's memory.

And then, you can dial from the carkit using the phonebook pushed from the other device.

The phones with note 2 allow to download the "call history" of the phone to the car kit.

For the non-compatible phones, the "call history" is available in the car kit with the calls dialed from the car kit.
